

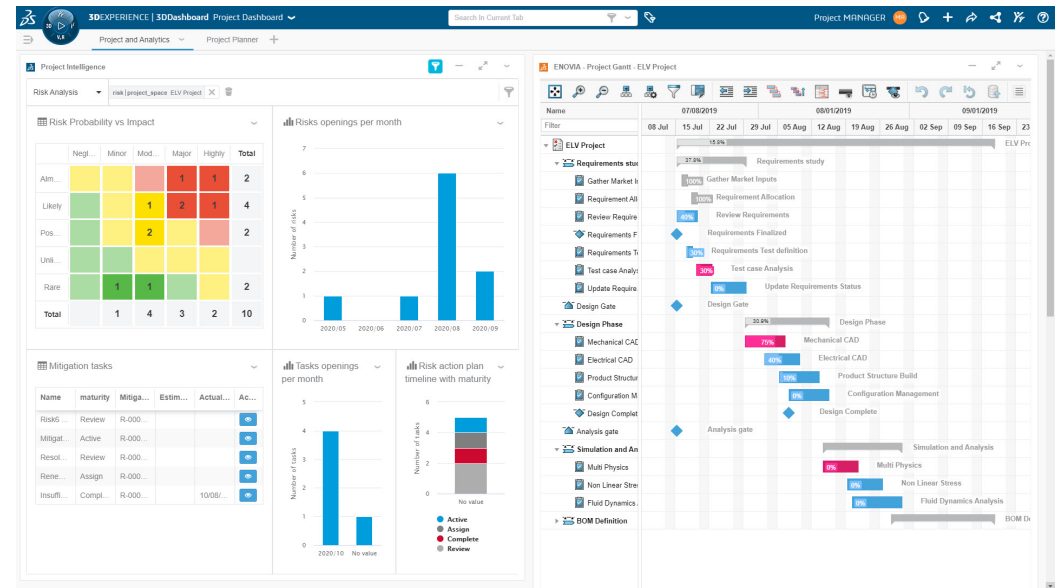
# Project Portfolio Manager (DPS)

Utilize actionable project intelligence for more effective decision making, prioritization and on-time delivery.

Project Portfolio Manager is a new role that comprises of Project Manager role (DPM) and Project Intelligence Consumer role (PIU /PUS). With this role, project managers can manage large number of projects, quickly apply filters to identify projects based on classification, or maturity, and launch risk analytics to those projects. Risk analysis involves assessment of all the risks associated with the project. The risks that are prioritized can be mitigated by associating them as contexts to collaborative tasks and assigning to users.

## Benefits

In addition to having all the benefits of a Project Manager role, Project Portfolio manager role enables users to carryout Project intelligence analytics. Project Portfolio Manager role provides diagnostic and predictive analytics capabilities to all project stakeholders. It delivers real-time progress consolidation to project managers, KPIs to monitor the planning health for project planners, and enables them to identify areas for improvement in order to make the right decisions. It also provides a cockpit view of project/program health for quick analysis of risk/resources for any team member, including executives.
